| <p>19th BAR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smart casual clothing or clean golf attire • Tailored shorts may be worn • Soft spikes with golf sports socks • Hats are not allowed | <p>COURSE/PUTTING GREEN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Golf shoes (either soft or metal spikes) are necessary • Smart golfing attire is required • Tailored shorts (with white sport socks to cover the ankles) are allowed • Headwear must be worn correctly |
| <p>OAK ROOM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jacket & tie for all Club meetings and prize giving events • Equivalent smart attire for ladies • Smart casual/clean golf attire may be worn when the Oak Room is used as a lounge facility, normally prior to 7.00pm | <p>MOBILE PHONES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be turned off on the course • May be switched on in the Clubhouse but calls must be made and taken outside |
